

Wolfville Baptist Church Announcements for Sunday, Feb 15, 2026

Our Guest Preacher this week is **the Rev. Dr. Elias M. Mutale**. Originally from Zambia, Dr. Mutale is the Lead Pastor of South End Baptist Church in Dartmouth and has also served as Moderator of the African United Baptist Association of Nova Scotia. He came to faith in 1975 during his final year of high school and soon emerged as a Christian leader, becoming the first Operations Director of World Vision Zambia in 1979. He began theological studies in 1987 and, in 1988, moved with his family to Wolfville to complete a Bachelor of Theology at Acadia Divinity College; Wolfville Baptist Church was the first church they attended in Canada. He later earned a Master of Divinity and a Doctor of Ministry. In March 2013, Dr. Mutale and his wife, Sheena, joined the Serving in Mission Canada missionary team, where they developed the Culture Connections portfolio in Metro Halifax while also supporting and strengthening Christian leadership development programs for pastors in Zambia.
