Job Description

Working with the Pastoral staff, Family Ministries Team, and volunteers, the Summer Ministry Program Leader will:

- Research and assess summer recreational programs available in the community and discern unmet needs and underserved groups.
- Develop a holistic summer recreation program for children and youth that fills community program gaps and includes off-site, outdoor, and indoor activities.
- Promote the program using creative online and traditional media.
- Manage advance and on-site registration.
- Plan and execute the day-to-day program activities. This will include gathering supplies and equipment, ensuring the safety of participants, and preparing materials.
- Using a curriculum, provide Children's and Youth Ministry for Sunday Services and Vacation Bible Camp.
- Keep up-to-date electronic records.
- Manage and be accountable for the summer programming budget.
- Evaluate the program against established goals and provide a written report to the Family Ministries Team.
