Wolfville Baptist Church is seeking a part-time **Interim Next Generation Leader** to provide spiritual leadership for our children, youth, and young adults (ages 0-30). We are looking for someone who is passionate about helping the next generation grow as fully devoted followers of Jesus.

Salary will be based on qualifications and experience.

Key Responsibilities

In collaboration with the Board of Christian Education, the Next Generation Leader will provide oversight and leadership in the following areas:

A. Each Week – School Year (September to June)

1. Plan Sunday morning programs for children and youth throughout the year (including summer). Every Day God Encounters (EDGE) Kids & EDGE Youth (pre-school to Grade 5) serve approximately 12-15 children and 14-17 youth each Sunday morning.
2. Lead EDGE Unlimited (Grades 6-12), serving approximately 18-23 teens each Friday evening.
3. Organize College & Career (ages 18-30), serving approximately 6-12 young adults each Sunday evening.

B. Each Week – Summer (July and August)

1. Plan and lead weekly Sunday morning programming during the months of July and August.
2. Plan and lead summer activities for children, youth, and young adults during the months of July and August.
3. Be the Coordinator of Vacation Bible School scheduled August 10-14, 2026.

C. Events

1. Plan participation in events such as Camp Intermission (May), One Conference (June), and Challenge (October).
2. Support the Coordinator of Messy Science Days when needed (normally Nova Scotia Heritage Day, Annapolis Valley Regional Centre for Education (AVRCE) Marking Day (end of June), and Remembrance Day).

Messy Science Day is a program where children in Grade Primary to Grade 5 can ask questions, experiment, and marvel at the wonders of science. Through hands-on activities, they uncover how science and faith beautifully complement each other.

3. Organize creative community outreach opportunities as time allows.

D. Throughout the Year

1. Be available for individual meetings with families and young adults upon request.
2. Work with the Board of Christian Education to ensure volunteer leaders and assistants are trained and scheduled. The Next Generation Leader will coordinate volunteer teams; not all programs are led alone.
3. Serve collaboratively and in conjunction with other members of the Ministry Team at Wolfville Baptist Church.

Qualifications

- A clear and growing commitment to Jesus Christ, with an active and vibrant personal witness.
- Integrity, openness, and transparency, with a genuine love for people and the ability to form meaningful relationships.
- A passion for ministry with children, youth, and young adults.
- The energy and ability to organize and lead activities, such as various sports and access to the natural environment.
- Strong communication skills across ages and platforms, including social media.
- Significant and relevant experience working with children and youth in a Christian context.
- Ability to meet Wolfville Baptist Church's legal screening requirements (including Criminal Record Check and Child Abuse Registry Check) for working with children and youth.
- Training in Christian Education and/or discipleship is an asset.

- A theological degree from a recognized university or college is an asset.

This position includes weekend and evening work with occasional overnights. Travel expenses will be reimbursed for pre-approved trips to events, camps, and conferences for the ministry of the church.

Review of Applications will begin Sunday, March 8, 2026, and continue until the position is filled.
